Why Dental Implants?



It has been more than 30 years since the introduction of osseointegrated dental implants. However many restorative dentists throughout the country still face the same perceived obstacles when it comes to incorporating implant dentistry into their practices. The perceptions include:

- Most Restorative Training Courses Are Not Effective
- Conventional Dentistry Is More Comfortable
